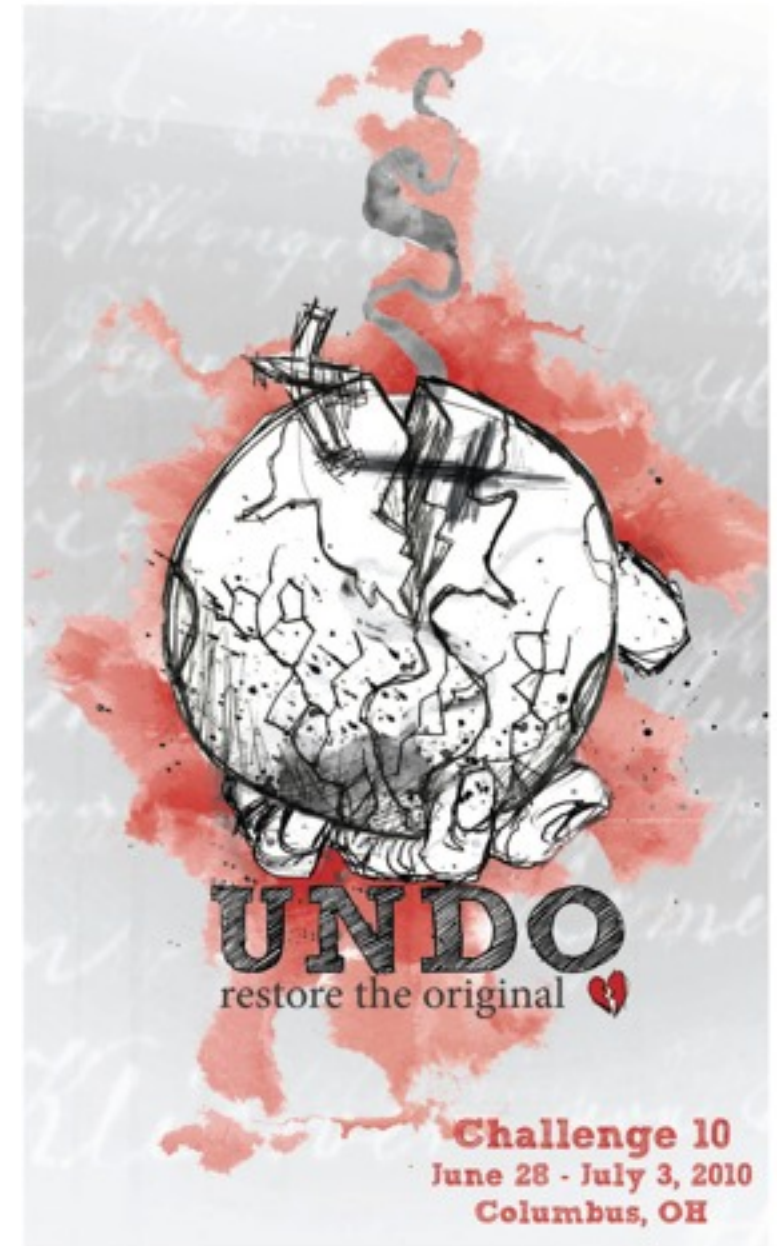
## FUNDRAISING
